This cultivar, named after the great gardener, deserves to be included in any selection because of its stunning, cherry red flowers, which are quite unique amongst perennial *erysimums*. Its precise origins are currently unknown to me, but it is said to have grown until recently at her home at Warley Place and since the 1930s at Spetchley Park.
